**Business Entry**

Analog strives to combine innovative materials, methods, and design solutions that address global and local conditions of site, context, construction techniques, and lifestyle. Our Studio / Shop is built with autoclaved, aerated, concrete block, a structural, insulating block w/ recycled content. This has been left raw to communicate its materiality and fabrication process. The steel cladding, which wraps the lower volume, as well as the steel exterior stair, has been allowed to weather. This eliminates the environmental impact of paint or coatings and shows the passage of time as a positive accretion of patina, as opposed to the negative deterioration and eventual maintenance of paint. A geo-thermal heat pump, which was designed and installed by Braxis Energy, is also used to heat, as well as cool, the space. This is one of the first uses of ground source cooling in our area.
